



Southbay Ski Club LODGE

(21618 Donner Pass Rd, Soda Springs, CA 95728)*



FACILITIES

1. Maximum capacity of the lodge is 19 persons in 3 dormitories upstairs.
2. Downstairs consists of a common room area, fully equipped kitchen, two separate bathrooms.
3. Private parking is limited to 6 spaces, left side of paved area.
4. Guests are welcome but must be accompanied by a member and have signed a waiver.
5. Lodging Rates are set by the Board of Directors and detailed in the *Schedule of Dues & Fees*.
6. There is no smoking and no pets allowed in the lodge at any time.
7. There are no telephone, television, or internet connections at the lodge.
8. Cell phones maybe used outside or inside in bad weather only.
9. There is a rack at the lodge entryway for ski storage. Please use it, and keep mess away from inside.
10. A brush for removing snow from skis and clothing hangs in the entryway, for the same purpose.
11. Bicycles may be secured under the porch.

RESERVATION POLICIES

1. Regardless of the Season, reservations for use of the lodge must be made in advance with the designated Reservation Coordinator who will insure equitable occupancy in accordance with the club's policy.
2. Reservation details are posted on the Club's calendar (Yahoo) for member's use.
3. Cancellation notification is also required if occupancy needs change.
4. Cancellation of a weekend reservation must be made by 5 PM the preceding Wednesday.
5. Unless cancelled by the deadline a member may be obligated for payment of any unused reserved nights.
6. A "no show" is only excused if Highway 80 is closed by Caltrans, not just bad weather.
8. No member may reserve space for more than a party of 10 (including the member, associate members and guests), unless vacancies remain within 7 days of the weekend.
10. Use of the lodge by large parties of 10 is limited to once per month.
11. The club may elect to reserve certain holiday weekends for exclusive member use.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Occupancy is recorded by Registration and Opening and Closing forms found by entry light switches.
2. Sign in on the REGISTRATION form to record your presence as soon as you enter the Lodge, even if you are arriving at a late hour or expect to occupy the lodge alone.
3. Opening and closing of the lodge must be performed by a club designated member ('Innkeeper') following instructions on the appropriate form to complete all details.
4. When ready to leave the Innkeeper is responsible for supervision of closing form to complete all details.
5. Finalized Registration, Open & Close forms along with fees and waivers must be collected and immediately forwarded to the Treasurer who forwards significant details to Lodge Chair.

RESTRICTIONS

The lodge is a communal facility, offering a minimum of privacy. Courtesy and consideration are therefore important for the well being and enjoyment of members and guests.

1. After 10PM, activities and conversations downstairs should be conducted quietly.
2. Sleeping overnight downstairs is not acceptable.
3. Portable heaters are ONLY allowed in the bathrooms and must be "OFF" when unattended.
4. All perishable food must be taken home, leaving both refrigerators clean and ready for next arrival.
5. Minimal, dated, non perishable food, staples, condiments, and packaged foods may be left for future use.
9. Be attentive to refrigerator temperature to avoid accidental freezing, but avoid altering control settings.
10. Each group or individual using the kitchen is responsible for promptly cleaning the area after each meal.

TIPS FOR THE PARKING LOT

1. The right hand lane of parking belongs to our neighbors, the Culloms. DO NOT park in their area.
2. Those leaving early in the morning should position their cars the night before.
3. For cars driven through water or slush, the parking brake can freeze. Consider chocking the wheels securely with firewood rather than setting the parking brake.
4. Do not leave any pieces of wood in the parking lot as they can damage the snow plow.
5. The driveway is plowed daily as needed by a contractor. The plow operator has no horn and will not wait for us to move our cars. The county plows may leave a berm which we must shovel.
